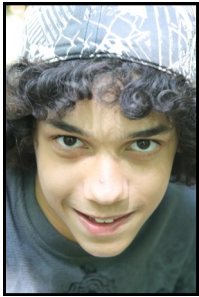


Day Camp

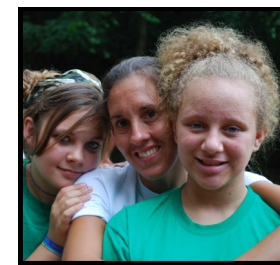
